4.4 Cadet A-class	Please note that it is <u>allowed</u> for all cadet A-class fighters to make contact to the head. All cadet competitors must provide a liability of weaver signed by <u>themself</u> and <u>legal guardian</u> . It is not allowed for coaches to sign this document! If this document is not signed and not accompanied with a signature and proof of identification of the legal guardian the competitor will be excluded from the competition <u>For cadet B-class fighters it is NOT ALLOWED to make contact to the head.</u>
4.5 Competition mode	17 years juniors may compete as a junior or senior, competing in <u>both categories is NOT allowed.</u>

8.<u>Rules</u>

<u>8.1</u> Liability	Only members of National Federation's affiliation with ETU are allowed to compete. For countries without any federation being member of ETU, affiliation with WTF is necessary. Upon registration, the contestants must prove their memberships by means of a valid license. All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk. The organization and supervisor assume no responsibility for teams, any damages, violence, loses and injuries. All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in the Netherlands. If not, this will have to be paid in cash.
<u>8.2</u> Coach	For every 5 contestants within the same team, one coach is granted free admission, with a maximum of 6 coaches. Only competitors and coaches have admittance to the competition areas. Coaching is only allowed in sportswear. All coaches must 18 years or older!







<u>8.3 Equipment</u>	WTF-recognized gear and groin, forearm and shin protector, which are compulsory, will be brought by the contestants. Tooth protectors are compulsory!
<u>8.4 Protest</u>	Only the official coach is a allowed to protest, immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of € 50,00 (Euro) will have to be paid for each protest and will be returned if the protest was found valid. The decision of the judge is final.
