REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS AND COACHES:

- To register players please visit www.ma-regonline.com and sign into your account.
- All competitors and coaches must have a valid membership at the time of registration and competition.
- Any competitor or coach who fails the audit will not be allowed to participate in the competition. At this stage no refunds will be given.
- It's the responsibility of the coach/instructor to ensure that theirs and their player's details are entered correctly, including the membership number.
- All competitors MUST bring their an ID to the weigh in and on the day of the competition.

- Juniors born in 2007 may compete as a senior
- Veterans may compete as a senior
- Weight divisions with only one competitor in may be combined with an adjoining weight group and or classification.
- All pee wee matches will be 3 x 1 min rounds, all other categories will be 3 x 1.5 min rounds.

PAYMENT :

Weigh In:

- Calibrated digital scales will be used and a maximum of 0.09 grams (0.099KG) leniency will be granted.
- Weight changes can be made for a £20 fee, payable at the weigh in.

Saturday 22nd June 2024, at the competition venue:

- Weigh in will open 4pm to 6pm (All age groups)

Sunday 23rd June 2024 at the competition venue:

- Weigh in will be open 7:30am to 9am

Competition Draw:

- The competition draw will take place immediately after the weigh in closes on the Sunday.
- Once the weigh in closes no changes will be made.
- Competitors may be moved up or down one weight group.

Awards:

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be handed out.
- The Top 3 teams will receive a Team trophy and cash Prize*
- Gold - 7 points
- Silver - 3 points
- Bronze - 1 point
- 3 points for every match won.

COMPETITION RULES

Rules

- Full WT rules to be applied, including full contact to the body and head shots for all age and skill groups.
- There will be coach's meeting at approximately 9:30am for any update to the competition schedule and competition rules.

Instant Video Review (IVR)

- There will be no video replay system for this tournament.
- However, a Referee review card appeal system will be utilised in accordance with British Taekwondo competition practices.

Protests

- Any protests must be made by the club coach within 10 minute of the end of the contest to the chief referee.
- The protest fee is £35 (refunded if protest is won)

Behaviour

- All participants-spectators, competitors, coaches, officials- are expected to behave in an appropriate manner.
- Any inappropriate behaviour will be dealt with by the competition organiser and offenders will be asked to leave, and in extreme cases reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board.
- The protest fee is £35 (refunded if protest is won)
- We support British Taekwondo policy of ZERO TOLERANCE on swearing and including racist behaviour and extreme violent remarks of any nature — offenders will be asked to leave and in extreme cases reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board and Police where appropriate.

Coaches

- 1 coach will be accredited for every 5 competitors entered and granted free admission.
- a Coaches will only be permitted at ringside in sportswear.
- The minimum age of the coach must be 18 years.
- All coaches must register in advance on www.ma-regonline.com providing correct information. On the deadline date the information entered will be passed to British Taekwondo for completion of the audit. Coaches who have entered incorrect information or who fail the audit will not be allowed to coach.
