# Detailed Tournament Outline

## Procedure:

- Clubs should register for the event **in advance** using [www.ma-regonline.com](http://www.ma-regonline.com)
- Each Competitor and Coach must be entered accurately, including their British Taekwondo Membership Number (UK competitors only)
- Once the entry deadline has been reached the competitor list will go to the British Taekwondo Membership Audit
- **Competitors whose Memberships have not been renewed by this date will not pass the audit**
- Competitors not passing the audit will be removed from the entry list for the tournament and will not be permitted to compete
- Coaches not passing the audit will not be permitted to coach
- Competitors not passing the audit will be charged the full entry fee by the event organiser

## Eligibility of Applicants:

- All competitors must have a valid British Taekwondo Membership and insurance or those if competing from abroad must have a valid licence through their National Association; numbers will be checked with Membership Services.
- All competitors should check that their insurance is valid and ensure that **April 2019 renewals** are processed in time before the competition closing date of **03 May 2019**.

## Entry Fees:

- A/B class competitors: Clubs pay £35 per entry to the competition whether they compete or not
- Spectators: £5 per person, FREE for under 5s

## Competition Draw:

- The competition draw will take place after the weigh in on **Sunday 12 May 2019** and will be posted on [www.maregonline.com](http://www.maregonline.com).
- Where only 1 competitor remains in a group following the weigh in, they will be merged into another group using the following guidelines:
  - A and B class groups may be merged if necessary, and may not necessarily use Dae Do PSS for scoring
  - Competitors may be moved up 1 weight group only
  - Pee Wee and Child age groups will compete first

## Rules:

- Full WT rules to be applied, including **full contact** to the **body** and **head shots** for **all age and skill groups**
- See "Scoring Systems for this Event" page for how scoring will be conducted

## Instant Video Review (IVR):

- There will be no Video Replay system for this tournament
- However, a Referee Review card appeal system will be utilised in accordance with British Taekwondo competition practices

## Weigh In:

*Calibrated digital scales will be used, and a **maximum** of 0.099kg (99 grams) leniency will be granted*  
**Saturday 11 May 2019**

- There will be a weigh in at the competition venue from 4.00pm – 5.00pm for all competitors
- Competitors attempting to weigh in at this session will not be permitted to re-try the following day
- Changes to weight groups at this time will require an administration fee of £10
- Competitors entered into the wrong age/Class categories will require an administration fee of £10

### **Sunday 12 May 2019**

- There will be a weigh in on the morning of the competition at the competition venue
  - 7.30am – 8.30am for all Pee Wee and Child competitors
  - 8.30am – 9.30am for all Cadet, Junior, Senior and Veteran competitors
  - Changes to weight groups at this time will require an administration fee of £10
  - Competitors entered into the wrong age/Class categories will require an administration fee of £10

## Protests:

- Any protests must be made by the club coach within 10 minutes of the end of the contest to the Chief Referee.
- The Protest fee is £35 (refunded if protest is won).

## Awards:

- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medal awards shall be made for each category.
- The top 3 teams will each receive a trophy to celebrate their top 3 standing by points awarded as follows:
  - Gold - 7pts, Silver - 3pts, Bronze - 1pt, 3 pts for each win

## **Behaviour:**

- All participants – spectators, competitors, coaches, officials – are expected to behave in an appropriate manner
- Any inappropriate behaviour will be dealt with by the competition organiser and offenders will be asked to leave, and in extreme cases, reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board
- We support British Taekwondo's policy of ZERO TOLERANCE on swearing – and include in this, racist behaviour and extreme violent remarks of any nature – offenders will be asked to leave, and in extreme cases, reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board and police where appropriate

## **Other Information:**

- The Competition Organiser has the right to make any necessary changes to the above information.
- All competitors participate at their own risk, and neither the organisers nor the British Taekwondo shall accept responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses sustained or incurred.

## Manual scoring

Competitors will need to bring their own head guard, gum shield, body protector, forearm guards, gloves, groin guard and shin guards. All must be WT or British Taekwondo approved.

## Electronic head & body scoring

Competitors will need the same protective gear as Manual scoring, with the exception of the body protector and head guard which will be provided by the tournament organisation. Competitors will also require Dae Do electronic sensor socks.
