03 Contestant Eligibility

All contestants must be members of British Taekwondo and must be a UK resident. Non British nationals will be allowed to compete at this event provided they are authorised through their governing body to attend. Membership - All contestants and coaches must have a valid membership at the time of registration (via MA-REG) and at the time of the competition. Unfortunately, any competitor or coach who fails at registration cannot take part in the competition. Any entry fees cannot be refunded in this case. We urge all participants to make arrangements now, to ensure their memberships are up to date well before the competition date. Seniors (17 Years & above) Born 2002 or before

Senior Male: -58kg, -68kg, -80kg and +80kg Senior Female: -49kg -57kg -67kg and +67kg

Veterans Born in 1984 or before

Senior Male: -58kg -68kg -80kg +80kg Senior Female: -49kg -57kg -67kg +67kg

Note: Juniors aged 17 may also compete in the Senior event in addition to the Junior group. Also, veterans may compete in the senior categories. An additional entry and second entry fee should be submitted.

Classes: A Class players, (Cadet and Above only) in the Open Competition, all grades and ages may enter the 1-2-1.

A Class Definition: 2nd Kup (Red Belt) and above.

All Advanced athletes must bring their own Daedo E-Foot Protectors.

All PeeWee and Children's Matches (in the 1-2-1) to be 3X 1min Rounds. All cadet, Junior, Senior & Veteran Matches to be 3X 1.5min Rounds











05 Applications

All applications are to be made online at Martial Arts Registration Online. www.ma-regonline.com.

Please note: For the Open Competition we will allow changes in competitor weight groups should a player fail the weigh-in (subject to an administration fee of £10.00 payable at the time of the weigh-in). In addition, groups with single competitors will be combined with adjoining weight groups to ensure that all players will have the opportunity to compete. All coaches are responsible for ensuring their players weight and entry details are correct as no refunds will be given should any player be disqualified or not wish to pay the administration fee to move weight groups. All information must be entered when registering players. Any player found not to have entered the correct membership number and all other requested information may be removed from the system. Payment is required by no later than Friday 15th June 2019. Following the entry deadline, any changes may only be made at registration/weigh-in. For the 1-2-1 Competition, To ensure fair matching of players, PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR PLAYERS DETAILS ARE UP TO DATE AND THAT ACCURATE INFORMATION IS PROVIDED WITH REGARD TO WEIGHT, ABILITY AND GRADE.

06 Closing Date

The closing date for applications is 8.00pm on Friday 15th June 2019. We would appreciate immediate payment by BACS Transfer once registration closes.

07 Coaching Accreditation

One coach will be accredited for every five competitors entered and granted free admission. There can be a maximum of 4 coaches per team. Additional coaching passes may be purchased for £10 each by completing a coaches' application online. This must be done at the same time as you pay entry fees. The minimum age for a coach must be 18 years. Coaches will only be permitted at ringside in appropriate sportswear, no shorts. All coaches must hold a British Taekwondo membership and Instructors Indemnity Insurance. Passes will only be issued if the membership information is completed in full online. Coaches must collect their passes personally at the dedicated Coaches registration desk. All coaches must register online prior to the deadline date. Once this deadline has passed no further coaches will be added. All information must be given online or coaches will be removed from the system.







08 Registration, Weigh In, & Draw

Registration & Weigh-In

There will be a registration & weigh-in on Saturday 22nd June 2019 between 6:30pm until 7:30pm at the Doncaster Dome. There will be a further weigh-in on the Sunday morning of the event between 7:30am and 8:30am. Athletes are advised to consult British Taekwondo's Policy on Making Weight for Training and Competition.

The drawing of lots will take place on the morning of the Competition.

Rules

Full WT Competition Rules will be applied. Appeals will be dealt with on court, during individual matches, using a coaches card system (for the Open Competition). Full details of this process will be given to coaches at the event briefing. For the Open Competition all players will be supplied with Daedo Electronic Body and Head Protectors (GEN2 PSS). For the 1-2-1, all players must bring their own full body and head protection.







10 Awards

Awards will be presented to all tournament champions and 2nd and 3rd places. Team trophies will also be presented for the overall team winners. All 1-2-1 Entrants will receive a trophy.

11 Equipment

Advanced Senior, Advanced Junior, and Advanced Cadet players in the Open Competition will be provided with Daedo electronic body and head protectors. In the 1-2-1 Competition, all contestants must provide their own standard non-electronic body protector. All must wear the required protective equipment: WT recognised head guard, WT recognised body protector, groin guard, shin guards, arm guards, hand gloves and clear or white gum shields. A list of companies which supply WT recognised protective equipment can be found on the World Taekwondo website. All contestants will be required to proceed to the inspection desk for officials to check their dobok and protective equipment before entering the competition area. Any contestant wearing unofficial equipment will not be permitted to compete.

12 Liability

All competitors are considered to be participating at their own risk. British Taekwondo, the WTA and the organisers assume no responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses. By submitting a competitor or coach application you are confirming that you are fit and able to take part in this WT Taekwondo competition and do not suffer from any illness or condition that would prevent you from taking part. You also agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of British Taekwondo.

13 Entry & Payment

The entry fee for each Open Competition Kyorugi contestant is £35.00. For the 1-2-1 Competition, the entry fee is £30. Team payments to be transferred by Friday 15th June, 2019. Entry fees must be paid for whole team/club registrations only (no individual payments); to the following bank account:
