World Taekwondo Single Elimination (A&B Class)

Scoring:

KPNP Electronic scoring for advanced grades

Awards:

Gold, Silver and 2 Bronze for individual weight classes
Team Awards for top 3 teams

Round Times:

3 x 1.30 minute round with a 30 second rest interval

Medical:

Paramedics and First Aiders will be in attendance for all courts

Equipment:

KPNP Body & Head Gear will be provided by the host for all Advanced Children, Cadet, Junior, Senior and Veteran weight classes.

All players must wear the correct PPE recognised by World Taekwondo. Groin, Arm, Leg, Gloves & clear/white mouth- piece. All players must provide their own PPS Socks

All novice weight classes will play on non- PSS and provide their own Body armour & Head Gear as well as their PPE.

All players will be required to pass inspection for officials to check the equipment for safety and compliance to WT Rules. Any player wearing non- recognised equipment will not be allowed to compete.

Classes:

A Class: 2nd Kup (Red belt) and above

B Class: 9th Kup (Yellow Tag) to 3rd Kup (Red Tag)

Age Classification:

Junior players aged 17 can enter a Senior weight class in addition to their Junior weight class. Also, any Veterans wishing to compete in a Senior weight class can do so. For every additional entry a second entry fee must be paid.

Saturday 18th January from 6:00pm to 8:00pm

Pee Wee Children & Cadet Weight Classes:

Sunday 19th January from 7:30am to 8:30am

Junior & Senior Weight Classes

Sunday 19th January from 8:30am to 10:00am

Weigh In Notes:

Coaches : please ensure you weigh and enter your players correctly

Players who don't make their weight according to the one stated on their entry/ application form can move weight class at a cost of £20.00 payable at the weigh in.

Players can amend their weight group after the deadline via email right up to the Friday before the event.

All applications are to be made online at: ma-regonline.com

Closing Date for Applications:

Friday 10th January - 9pm

Application Numbers:

Applications are limited to 400 players.

Application Costs:

All players entered on ma-regonline.com are to pay for entry in full, even if they do not attend. There will be no option to remove or delete players once they are submitted and all fees are due.

British Taekwondo Audit & Withdraws:

Any player who fails an eligibility audit conducted by British Taekwondo that is registered or withdraws after being entered on ma-regonline.com is still liable to pay.

British Taekwondo Eligibility:

All players and coaches must have a valid, in date British Taekwondo Licence. The correct M Number is needed to register on ma-regonline.com and any M Numbers that are incorrect or falsified in any way, will fail the audit and will not be entitled to a refund.

Cost of Entry for Players:

£40:00 for all weight classes

Entry Payments:

Payment is required from all teams as soon as possible after applications have been registered on ma-regonline.com

Application Notes:

It is advised that all coaches/ instructors ensure that any British taekwondo licence renewals are done in plenty of time. Renewal applications should be with British Taekwondo at least 14 day prior to the closing date.



Coaches:

All coaches must be at least 18 years of age

One (1) coach will be accredited for every five (5) players will gain free entry to the Championship

Maximum of five (5) coaches per team will be granted free entry.

Any additional coaches registered, are more than welcome coach at a cost of £25:00 per coach.

All coaches are permitted to wear sports wear courtside.

All coaches must register in advance on ma-regonline.com

Any coach that fails the British Taekwondo Audit will not be allowed to coach their players at the Championship.

Referees:

Referees wishing to participate at our Championships can you please contact the Referee Director for the event. Your support is always appreciated.

Protests:

In the unlikely event that you believe a situation or decision warrants a protest. A fee of £40:00 per protest is to be made to the Competition Supervisory Board immediately after the end of the given contest in question by the team's head coach only. The outcome of your protest will be reviewed and the Referee Director decision will be final.

Cost of Entry for Spectators:

Tickets are available on the door and are cash only.
