# DETAILED TOURNAMENT OUTLINE

## PROCEDURE

- Entries should be made online at [www.ma-regonline.com](http://www.ma-regonline.com)
- All players and coaches should be entered accurately with the correct British TKD M number from the outset - players or coaches added with fictitious M numbers may be removed
- Once we have passed the entry deadline, all players and coaches submitted will be included in the British TKD membership audit
- Following the audit, players or coaches with expired memberships will be removed from the event
- Competitors not passing the audit will be charged the full entry fee by the event organiser
- There will be no merging of weight categories for Cadet Worlds events
- There will be no merging of weight categories for U21 European events
- Drawsheets will be published from 21:00 on Saturday 11th June 2022

## COACH ACCREDITATION

Four (4) coaches will be accredited and granted free admission. Additional coaching passes may be purchased for £20.00 by completing a coaches' application online for each additional pass required. This must be paid at the same time as you pay entry fees. The minimum age for a coach must be 18 years old. Coaches will only be permitted at ringside in appropriate sportswear, no shorts. All coaches must hold a current British Taekwondo membership, Instructors Indemnity Insurance and must possess a valid Criminal Records Check document (DBS). Coach's passes will only be issued if the coach's membership information is completed in full online. Coaches must bring and show PHOTO identification at registration to collect coaches passes and team packs and must attend in person. All coaches must register online prior to the deadline date. Once this deadline has passed no further coaches will be added. All information must be given online or coaches will be removed from the system



# ELIGIBILITY OF PARTICIPANTS

- All competitors must have a valid British Taekwondo Membership and insurance
- All players and coaches should check and ensure that their memberships is valid for the date of both events. Please check this prior to the deadline for each event
- All competitors must be a valid British Passport holder
- All competitors must hold a minimum 1st Poom for Cadet Worlds Championship
- All competitors must hold a minimum 1st Kup for U21 European Championship

- All selected athletes must have a valid GAL license post selection

# COMPETITOR ENTRY CATEGORIES

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

### CADET

- These categories officially come in to use on 1st June 2022 so will be used at the World Championships & our events
- Please note these categories are subject to change if World Taekwondo make any late amendments
- Cadet events will use KP&P PSS System
- The athlete with the highest number of ranking points after the 2 events will be automatically selected
- In the event of a tie. There will be a single match fight off with the winner being automatically selected.

### U21

- Please note these categories are subject to change if World Taekwondo Europe make any late amendments
- Under 21 events will use Daedo PSS System
- The athlete with the highest number of ranking points after the 2 events will be automatically selected
- In the event of a tie. There will be a single match fight off with the winner being automatically selected
- If WTE allow each member nation to select 2 athletes per category (as previous) then the following criteria will apply
- If there are 4 or more participants in any given category across the 2 selection events then British Taekwondo will select the 1st ranked & 2nd ranked athletes to attend the U21 European Championship
- If there are less than a total of 4 participants in any given category across the 2 selection events then British Taekwondo will only select the 1st ranked athlete to attend the U21 European Championship

# COMPETITION SUMMARY

## AWARDS

1st Place shall be awarded Gold Medal and 10 ranking points  
2nd Place shall be awarded Silver Medal and 6 ranking points  
3rd Place shall be awarded Bronze Medal and 3.6 ranking points

## APPEALS

All appeals should be handled on the day by the referee director. A fee of £50:00 per protest is to be made to the Competition Supervisory Board immediately after the end of the given contest in question by the team's head coach only. The decision of the referee director is final.

Full details of the appeals process will be given to coaches at the event briefing.

## LIABILITY

All competitors are considered to be participating at their own risk. British Taekwondo and the organiser assume no responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses. By submitting a competitor or coach application you are confirming that you are fit and able to participate in this World Taekwondo competition and do not suffer from any illness or condition, including Covid, that would prevent you from taking part. You also agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of British Taekwondo.
