For all competitors, the weigh in will be on Saturday 18th February from 15:00 to 19:00. There will NOT be a weigh in on the morning of the competition. Please ensure you are at the venue for the given weigh in time.

Door will open at 8 AM and competition will start at 9AM.

Participant Eligibility

All participants (athletes and coaches) must have valid British Taekwondo membership. Anyone removed from the event system due to a lapsed membership will not be permitted to participate. Entry fees cannot be refunded in this case.

Competitors must bring and show photo identification at weigh in.

Coaches must bring and show photo identification at registration to collect coaches' passes and team packs and must attend in person.

Age Classification

Juniors born in 2006 can enter a senior weight class in addition to their junior weight class.

Veterans can compete in a senior weight class

For every additional entry, a second entry fee must be paid

Peewee and children matches will be 3 x 1 minute rounds with 30 seconds rest. Cadet, junior, senior and veteran matches will be 3 x 1.5 minute rounds with 1 minute rest.

Weight categories if there is only 1 athlete in their division Class categories will be combined

Daedo Electronic Body Protector systems and headguards will be used for all athletes competing.

Applications and Payment

All applications are to be made online at Martial Arts Registration Online: www.ma-regonline.com.

Closing date for applications: Sunday 5th February at 21:00 (or before if the maximum number of spaces has been reached*).

Payment is required a week after an athlete has been registered online to ensure that others wishing to participate are given fair opportunities. The list will be reviewed weekly to ensure that this is managed. We therefore encourage you to enter athletes whom you are sure will be participating.

Price: £45 per application

*The current event capacity is 350 athletes.

The entry portal will close at this point and a waiting list started. Waiting list entries are taken on a first come first served basis. There is no guarantee of entry for any entries on the waiting list.

Coaches must ensure that email address used to register is the email address that they can be contacted on for updates.

Coaches are responsible for ensuring that their players weight categories and entry details are correct as no refunds will be given should any player be disqualified or not wish to pay the administration fee to move weight groups.

Please note:

We will allow changes in competitor weight groups should an athlete fail the weigh-in (subject to an administration fee of £20 payable at the time of the weigh-in).

All information must be entered when registering players.

Any athlete remaining in the online system at the deadline will be responsible for paying the full entry fee even if that athlete does not compete.

Coaches:

Coaches must hold a valid British Taekwondo membership.

The minimum age for a coach is 18 years old.

Coaches' passes will only be issued if the above criteria are met.

All coaches must register online prior to the deadline date.

Once this deadline is passed, no further coaches will be added.

All information must be given online or coaches will be removed from the system.

Coaches will only be permitted at ringside if they have an athlete competing. They must wear appropriate attire (as outlined in section 4.3 of the British Taekwondo Field of Play (FOP) Protocol policy).

Registration and Weigh In

Registration and weigh in will be from 15:00 – 19:00pm Saturday 18th February Athletes are advised to consult the British Taekwondo policy on "Making Weight and Training for Competition".

The competition draw will take place immediately after weigh-in closes. A full set of draw sheets will be made available for any coaches and will be posted online at www.ma-regonline.com. These should be available at 20.00 on Saturday 18th February.

Coaches should pay particular attention for those athletes competing in the first few matches on each court and ensure they are at the venue in good times to warm up and prepare.

Competition Rules

Full World Taekwondo Competition Rules will be applied as per the new rules adopted 01/09/2022.

All athletes will be provided with Daedo Electronic body protector and e-headguards.
All athletes should bring their own Daedo socks and all other personal protective equipment.
All athletes must wear World Taekwondo or BT recognised uniforms and protective equipment.
All athletes will have to pass inspection by officials before entering the competition area. Any contestant wearing non-recognised or approved equipment will not be permitted to compete.

Jewellery and Piercings

All jewellery and piercings must be removed before athletes arrive at the inspection desk to prevent delays. Athletes may miss or forfeit their match if they cannot meet competition rules.

Awards

Awards will be presented to athletes who place 1st, 2nd and 2x 3rd places per category. Team trophies will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams.

Match Appeals

Appeals will be dealt with on court during individual matches using the coaches card system. Full details of the process will be given to coaches at the event briefing.

Bus
