Procedure

- Club should register for the event in advance using www.maregonline.com
- Each Competitor and Coach must be entered accurately, including their British Taekwondo Membership Number (UK competitors only)
- Once the entry deadline has been reached the competitor list will go on the British Taekwondo Membership audit
- Competitors whose Membership has not been renewed by this date will not pass the audit
- Competitors not passing the audit will be removed from the entry list for the tournament and will not be permitted to compete
- Coaches not passing the audit will not be permitted to coach
- Competitors not passing the audit will be charged the full entry fee by the event organiser

Eligibility of Applicants

- All competitors must have a valid British Taekwondo Membership and insurance or those competing from abroad must have a valid licence through their National Association; numbers will be checked with Membership Services.
- All competitors should check that their insurance is valid and ensure that December 2023 renewals are processed in time before the competition closing date of 30th November 2023.

Entry Fees:

- £50 per entry. Clubs must pay as a team. An invoice will be sent to all teams after the deadline date.
- Non payment will result in entries being removed from the Open.
- Clubs are expected to pay for competitors that do not show up or do not compete.
- Withdrawals: 50% penalty fee will incur if removed between 1-6 December 2023. Withdrawals made from 7 December 2023 will incur full entry fee.

- Competitors may be moved up 1 weight group only

Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Full WT rules to be applied, including full contact to the body and head shots for all age and skill groups
Video Replay	There will be no Video Replay system for this tournament, however, a Referee Review card appeal system will be utilised in accordance with British Taekwondo competition practices
Weigh In	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Calibrated digital scales will be used, and a maximum of 0.1Kg (100grams) leniency will be granted• Competitors attempting to weigh in at this session (and fail) will not be permitted to re-try the following day• Changes to weight groups at this time will require an administration fee of £20• Competitors entered into the wrong age/class categories will require an administration fee of £20• *PLEASE NOTE: PEEWEES AND CHILDREN WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO LOSE WEIGHT SHOULD THEY WEIGH IN OVER.
Protest	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any protest must be made by the club coach within 10 minutes of the end of the contest to the Chief Referee• The Protest fee is £50 (refunded if protest is won)
Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medal awards shall be made for each category• The top 3 teams will each receive a trophy to celebrate their top 3 standing by points awarded as follows:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Gold - 7pts, Silver - 3pts, Bronze - 1 pts, 3 pts for each win

Manual scoring

- Competitors will need to bring their own head guard, gum shield, body protector, forearm guards, gloves, groin guard and shin guards.
- All must be WT or British Taekwondo approved.

Electronic head & body scoring

- Competitors will need the same protective gear as Manual scoring, with the exception of the body protector and head guard which will be provided by the tournament organisation. Competitors will also require Daedo electronic sensor socks.

Behaviour:

- All participants - spectators, competitors, coaches, officials - are expected to behave in an appropriate manner
- Any inappropriate behaviour will be dealt with by the competition organiser and offenders will be asked to leave, and in extreme cases, reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board

- All the competitors participate at their own risk, and neither the organisers nor the British Taekwondo shall accept responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses sustained or incurred.
