Dear Instructors, coaches and players,

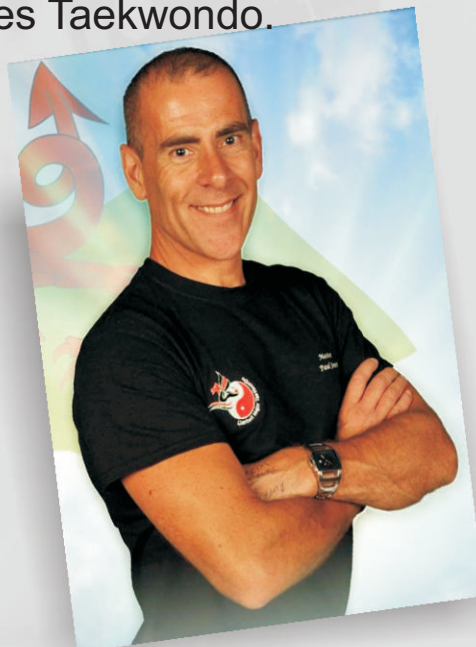
We would personally like to invite you to the 5th Welsh International Championships held at the Sport Wales National Centre, Cardiff, on the Sunday 22nd June 2025.

Rules

World Taekwondo Single Elimination

Scoring

PSS for all advanced A class athletes including Children, Cadet, Junior, Senior and Veteran. All Peewee and B class athletes will compete on manual scoring.

Equipment

KP&P, PSS scoring system will be in use.

PSS Hogu and head guard will be provided for all A class children, cadets, juniors and senior categories, these athletes must provide their own socks.

All players must wear the required WT approved protective equipment. A list of approved equipment can be found on the WT www.worldtaekwondo.org.

All contestants must proceed to the check-in desk for officials to check their dobok and protective equipment before entering the competition area. Any athlete wearing unofficial equipment will not be allowed to compete.

Event Summary

British Coaches

One (1) coach will be accredited for every five (5) competitors entered and will be granted free admission. There can be 4 coaches per team.

The minimum age for a coach must be 18 years old. Coaches will only be permitted at ringside in sportswear.

All coaches must register in advance on www.ma-regonline.com providing correct information. On the deadline date the information entered will be passed to British Taekwondo for competition audit. Coaches who have entered incorrect information or who fail the audit will not be allowed to coach.

Behaviour

All guests (participants, coaches, spectators and officials) are expected to behave in an appropriate manner. Any inappropriate behaviour may be subject to disciplinary action by the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board. We will also be implementing British Taekwondo's zero tolerance policy on swearing and offenders will be asked to leave.

Media/Photography

By attending the 4th Wales Taekwondo International Championships, you are agreeing to have your image taken whilst in the venue by both the press and members of the public. In addition, you are agreeing to have your image shown on video, TV and online. Any queries please contact the competition organisers.

Protests

Only the head coaches allowed to protest to the Competition Supervisory Board, immediately after the end of the contest in question. An amount of £50.00 will have to be paid for each protest lodged. The decision of the referee chairman is final.

Eligibility

All competitors and coaches must have a valid British Taekwondo licence and insurance. International players must have a valid licence through their National Association. An audit will be carried out by the organisers and any competitor or coach who fails the audit will not be entitled to a refund.

Any competitor who withdraws from the competition after the deadline must still be paid for by their club.

Awards

Medals awarded to 1st, 2nd and 2x 3rd places.

Team trophies awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

Weigh In

Players must be in the queue to weigh-in by 8.30am or they may be refused

Weight changes, should a competitor fail the weigh in, will incur an administration charge of £25.00 cash payable at the time of the weigh-in.

In addition, groups with single competitors will be combined with adjoining weight groups to ensure that all competitors have the opportunity to compete. Similarly, A and B classes won't be combined.

Juniors aged 17 may compete in the senior event in addition to the junior group. Veterans may compete in both veteran and senior categories.

All peewee matches will be 3x1 min rounds. All other categories 3x1.5 min rounds with 30 seconds rest.



Travel

By Coach

Located in Sophia Gardens, the National Sport Centre is also home to the National Express coach station. The venue can therefore be accessed by the National Express coach, bookable via www.nationalexpress.com.

By train (recommended)

Trains to Cardiff Central Station run regularly, connecting the city centre to the rest of the UK. Cardiff Central Station is located within a very short walking distance of several hotels in the city centre and the National Sport Centre can be accessed via a short taxi ride or bus.

By Bus

If taking the Cardiff bus to the National Sport Centre, the nearest bus stop is the Cardiff Bridge stop. This is about 0.4 miles from the venue (about a 7-minute walk).

Walking from the city centre

The National Sport Centre is a 15-minute walk from the city centre, for hotels, shopping, restaurants and entertainment.

By Car

Located just outside of the city centre, the National Sport Centre can be accessed directly by car by following the signs for the Sport Wales National Centre. However, there is limited parking within the National Sport Centre itself. Parking will also be available in the Coach Station adjacent to the centre's car park at a cost.

Tourism

Shopping

The city centre is a 10 minute walk from the National Sport Centre, or can be easily accessed by train, bus or car. Ample parking is available particularly within the St David's Centre and John Lewis, as well as various other locations. The St David's Centre is highly recommended for a wide range of shops and restaurants, as well as mini-golf and Cineworld. Queen's Street, which can be accessed via the St David's Centre, offers a further range of shops and restaurants. For something a little different, Cardiff has a network of historic arcades bustling with independent stores selling unique goods.

Bute Park

Bute Park, a listed historic park and garden, is located just opposite the National Centre. The park runs along the River Taff and includes the attraction of Cardiff Castle and a number of other buildings and structures of historical importance.

Principality Stadium

The Principality Stadium offers tours to the public and is just a 5-minute walk away along the banks of the River Taff.
