- Each Competitor and Coach must be entered accurately, including their British Taekwondo Membership Number (UK competitors only).
- Competitors not passing the audit will be removed from the entry list for the tournament and will not be permitted to compete.
- Coaches not passing the audit will not be permitted to coach.
- Competitors not passing the audit will be charged the full entry fee by the event organiser.
  - All competitors should check that their insurance is valid on the competition date.

- Female: -26kg, -29kg, -32kg, -36kg, -40kg -44kg, -48kg, +48kg

## Cadet (12-14 years). Born in 2013,2012,2011 - A & B CLASSES

- Male: -33kg, -37kg, -41kg, -45kg, -49kg, -53kg, -57kg, -61kg, -65kg, +65kg
- Female -29kg, -33kg, -37kg, -41kg, -44kg, -47kg, -51kg, -55kg, -59kg, +59kg

## Junior (15-17 years). Born in 2010, 2009, 2008 – A & B CLASSES

- Male: -45kg, -48kg, -51kg, -55kg, -59kg, -63kg, -68kg, -73kg, -78kg, +78kg
- Female -42kg, -44kg, -46kg, -49kg, -52kg, -55kg, -59kg, -63kg, -68kg, +68kg

## Senior (+17 years) Born in 2008 and above) - A & B CLASSES

# Detailed Tournament Outline



#### Peewee/Children:

A – Class: 3rd Kup and above (Reg Tag and above)

B – Class: 6<sup>th</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> Kup (Green Belt – Blue Belt)

C – Class: 9th Kup to 7<sup>th</sup> Kup (Yellow Tag – Green Tag Belt)

### Cadets/Juniors/Seniors:

A-Class: 3rd Kup and above (Red Tag and above)

B- Class: 9th Kup to 4th Kup (Yellow tag to blue belt)

- Please note white Belts are not allowed to compete for safety reasons.
- All veterans will be a combine category

System: KPNP will be used. All Advance Categories will be on Electronic. The organising committee will aim to provide some electronic socks on the day but cannot guarantee. All B and C Class will be on manual scoring

Where only 1 competitor remains in a group following the weigh in, they will be merged into another group using the following guidelines:

- A & B class group will not be merged
- Competitors may be moved up 1 weight group only

## Manual scoring

- Competitors will need to bring their own head guard, gum shield, body protector, forearm guards, gloves, groin guard and shin guards. Peewee and Children are allowed to wear helmets with visors for the B and C class categories
- All must be WT or British Taekwondo approved.

## **Electronic Head & Body Scoring**

Competitors will need the same protective gear as Manual scoring, with the
exception of the body protector and head guard which will be provided by the
tournament organisation. Competitors will also require KPNP electronic sensor
socks.

Full WT rules to be applied, including full contact to the body and head shots for all age and skill groups

£50 per entry. Clubs must pay as a team. An invoice will be sent to all teams after the deadline date. Non payment will result in entries being removed from the Open.

Clubs are expected to pay for competitors that do not show up or do not compete.

Withdrawals: 50% penalty fee will incur if removed between 18-24 January 2025 (5pm). Withdrawals made from 25<sup>th</sup> January 2025 5pm will incur full entry fee.

There will be no Video Replay system for this tournament, however, a Referee Review card appeal system will be utilised in accordance with British Taekwondo competition practices

Calibrated digital scales will be used, and a maximum of 0.1Kg (100grams) tolerance for underwear will be granted for Pewees and Children categories.

Changes to weight groups at this time will require an administration fee of £20 Competitors entered into the wrong age/class categories will require an administration fee of £20

Any protest must be made by the club coach within 10 minutes of the end of the contest to the Chief Referee

The Protest fee is £50 (refunded if protest is won)







#### **AWARDS:**

1st, 2nd & 3rd place medal awards shall be made for each category
The top 3 teams will each receive a trophy to celebrate their top 3 standing by
points awarded as follows:

Gold - 7pts, Silver - 3pts, Bronze - 1 pt

#### Behaviour:

- All participants spectators, competitors, coaches, officials are expected to behave in an appropriate manner
- Any inappropriate behaviour will be dealt with by the competition organiser and offenders will be asked to leave, and in extreme cases, reported to the British Taekwondo Disciplinary Board

- All the competitors participate at their own risk, and neither the organisers nor the British Taekwondo shall accept responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses sustained or incurred.
