- 3.6 Team Awards Best Team Selection Trophy (Olympic classification)
1st place: 7 points / 2nd place: 4 points / 3rd: 1 point

- 3.7 Identification According to the Dutch law all competitors & visitors needs to have a valid identification by means of a valid [driving licence](#), [passport](#) or other [official document](#)!

4.1	Age	Pupil male and female 6 until and including 8 years (B and C class) Aspirant male and female 9 until and including 11 years (B and C class) Cadet male and female 12 until and including 14 years (A and B class) Junior male and female 15 until and including 17 years (A, B and C class) Senior male and female 17 years and older (A, B and C class)
4.2	Classification	Pupil, Aspirant, Junior & Senior C Class 10 TH until and including 7 TH küp Pupil, Aspirant, Cadet, Junior, Senior B Class 6 TH until and including 3 RD küp Cadet, Junior & Senior A Class 2 ND küp and higher
4.3	Weight divisions	Pupils for male and female, all in separate pools. (No head contact) -21, -24, -27, -30, -34, -39, -44 and +44 kg Aspirant for male and female, all in separate pools. (No head contact) -28, -32, -36, -40, -45, -51, -57 and +57 kg Cadet male -33, -37, -41, -45, -49, -53, -57, -61, -65 and +65 kg Cadet female -29, -33, -37, -41, -44, -47, -51, -55, -59 and +59 kg Junior male -45, -48, -51, -55, -59, -63, -68, -73, -78 and +78 kg Junior female -42, -44, -46, -49, -52, -55, -59, -63, -68 and +68 kg Senior male -54, -58, -63, -68, -74, -80, -87 and +87 Senior female -46, -49, -53, -57, -62, -67, -73 and +73
4.4	Cadet A-class	Please note that it is <u>allowed</u> for all cadet A-class fighters to make contact to the head. All cadet competitors must provide a liability of weaver signed by <u>themselves</u> and <u>legal guardian</u> . It is not allowed for coaches to sign this document! If this document is not signed and not accompanied with a signature and proof of identification of the legal guardian the competitor will be excluded from the competition. <u>For cadet B-class fighters it is NOT ALLOWED to make contact to the head.</u>
4.4	Competition mode	17 year old juniors may not compete as a junior or at senior, <u>competing in both categories is NOT allowed.</u>

5. Weigh-in

5.1	Rules of weigh-in	Competitors may exceed their weight class with a maximum of <u>200 grams!</u> Weight
5.2	Weigh-in mode	Classes can be combined with the next weight division.
5.3	Competition	Our system will work with <u>fight numbers</u> .

7. Rules

- 7.1 Liability
Only members of National Federation's affiliation with ETU are allowed to compete. For countries without any federation being member of ETU, affiliation with WTF is necessary. Upon registration, the contestants must prove their memberships by means of a valid licence. All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk. The organisation and supervisor assume no responsibility for teams, any damages, violence, loses and injuries. All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in the Netherlands. If not, this will have to be paid in cash.
- 7.2 Coach
For every 5 contestants within the same team, one coach is granted free admission, with a maximum of 4 coaches. Only competitors and coaches have admittance to the competition areas. Coaching is only allowed in sportswear or in full suit. All coaches must 18 years or older!
- 7.3 First Aid
Will be provided by the organisation and are only to be used in case of emergency!
- 7.4 Equipment
Deado PSS (electronic body protector) will be provided by the organisation. Head gear, groin, forearm and shin protector, which are compulsory, will be brought by the contestants. Tooth protectors are compulsory!
- 7.5 Protest
Only the official coach is allowed to protest, immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of [€ 100,00 \(Euro\)](#), will have to be paid for each protest and will be returned if the protest was found valid. The decision of the judge is final.
